**Embassy of Ireland to Host Community Tree Planting**  
*18 New Trees Will Make 96 Planted to Restore the  
 Historic Landscape of Embassy Row*

Restore Mass Ave and its partner, [Casey Trees](#), will add 18 new trees to Embassy Row during our sixth Community planting on Friday October 22, 2010. The morning will demonstrate how foreign missions and US neighbors can work together for a greener city.

The event will bring to 96 the number of new trees the project has added to restore the historic landscape that made Massachusetts Avenue a world attraction a century ago.

Eight “Valley Forge” American elms will be added in the 2200 block, forming rows along the sidewalk in front of foreign mission offices listed at right. The Embassy of Ireland will also receive a tulip poplar tree near Sheridan Circle, which will fill in the ring of tulip poplars planted about 1900.

The Church of the Pilgrims [www.churchofthepilgrims.org](http://www.churchofthepilgrims.org) will get nine trees. This beautiful Gothic structure sits on an important but bare hill. The Church will get small flowering trees for beauty and contemplation and larger trees to shade the sidewalk.
